

Privacy & Data Usage Policy

At 49, we care about your privacy, and we want to be transparent about how we treat your personal information. The following Privacy Policy and Terms and Conditions govern all pages hosted on the 49 platform.

Please note that while we do our best to protect your privacy, our Terms of Use only apply to our pages, and the pages of other organisations we link to may have their own policies that differ from ours. Our Terms of Use may change from time to time, so please check back periodically.

Although our Sites may be accessed from outside of the United Kingdom, the Sites are directed to individuals and entities within the United Kingdom. If you are not located in the United Kingdom, please be aware that by using our Sites you are consenting to your information being transferred to the United Kingdom and that we might not offer the same level of privacy protection that would be required by your home country.

Furthermore, the safety of children is very important to us. Our Sites are not intended for children younger than 11 and we do not intend to collect personally identifiable information from children. Children should always ask a parent or legal guardian for express permission before sending personal information to anyone online.

Website Usage

Most areas of our site are accessible without having to provide personal information of any kind. 49 Commitment to Online Security

Physical, electronic, and managerial procedures have been employed to safeguard the security and integrity of personal information. All 49 contractors with access to personal information obtained on the 49 website are also bound to adhere to this policy as part of their contract.

Collection of Information

When you are on 49's website or within the 49 platform and are asked for personal information, you are sharing your information only with 49, unless we tell you otherwise. 49 may collect information regarding website visitors, including IP address, browser and domain information, and information volunteered by you, such as email address or mobile phone number. We may also track visitor usage patterns of our website including website hits using standard site tracking software, such as Google Analytics, by placing first party and/or third party cookies (see Use of Cookies below) on devices that access the Sites and on the Sites of partners, clients, or pro-bono initiatives.

We also collect Personally Identifiable Information (PII) from email digital advertising we conduct and that conducted on behalf of clients or through our pro-bono work.

Use of Information

49 uses the information we collect about you to be able to keep you updated on our activities, help administer and improve our websites, and analyse the data for internal purposes.

Personally Identifiable Information (PII)

49 collects PII from our visitors, and we collect it through our survey responses in the platform. Our web server does not automatically recognise or collect PII based on your email address; the PII we collect from you is always voluntarily submitted by you.

49 is not responsible for the use of PII by its partner organisations or clients. Please consult the Sites of those companies for information concerning their privacy policies.

We treat unsubscribes in email correspondences as an opt-out from both future and past collection of data on behalf of the sending entity. This opt-out will remove your PII from our database.

Use of Cookies

Cookies are small text-only files that are stored on your computer and that can be used to help identify you when you visit a website.
